Project Name: PEI Convention Centre / Delta Hotel, Charlottetown, Prince Edward Island

The new Prince Edward Island Convention Centre, the flag ship of Charlottetown's waterfront, opened its doors in August of 2013. The Facility is connected to the 211-room Delta Prince Edward Hotel. The Convention centre features a multi-functional main ballroom with 24,000 sq. ft. of space which is divisible into six separate rooms. In addition two sections of the ballroom offer floor-to-ceiling windows with a spectacular water view. In addition to the main Confederation Ballroom, there are six break-out rooms with stunning views of the Charlottetown waterfront, two permanent executive boardrooms and two conference offices. An added feature of the new facility is the outdoor patio overlooking the scenic waterfront, able to accommodate up to 600 delegates for an outdoor reception.

The new Convention Centre allows Prince Edward Island to attract larger meetings and conferences with up to 1,500 delegates under one roof.

The facilities electrical systems include power distribution systems, emergency power distribution, building lighting control systems complete with low voltage computerized control, special ballroom and exterior feature lighting including the use of white as well as color changing RGB LED lighting systems, card access control system, audio and video distribution system, data communications systems, local sound reinforcement systems and life safety systems.

The total project cost is estimated at approximately \$20,000,000 with a total estimated electrical construction cost of approximately \$2,200,000.
