Project Name: Young Canada Games Sports Centre, University of Prince Edward Island, Charlottetown, Prince Edward Island

The Young Canada Games Sports Centre is the sports centerpiece for the University of Prince Edward Island. Originally built in 1990 for the Canada Games, it now serves the sporting and recreation needs of the University, as well as the community.

The \$6,500,000, 63,000 square foot facility features a main sports floor that is configured for 3 basketball courts, 3 volley ball courts, or up to 12 badminton courts. The main sports floor also has a spectator seating of 1,450 persons. The Facility also has an aerobics room, two lane jogging track, 2 racket ball/squash courts, weight training room, locker rooms and saunas, sports physiotherapy centre, as well as common area in public spaces. Some of the electrical systems incorporated into the design of this facility include a multi-level metal halide gymnasium lighting system, scoreboard, sound reinforcement, fire alarm and communication systems.
